## A Brooklyn Folly? Someone's Not Happy at 110 Livingston



Stephanie from [IntoTheBox.tv](#) sent this video about the lawsuit over alleged square footage fraud at 110 Livingston, the former Board of Ed headquarters that Mayor Bloomberg called a "notorious Kremlin" and Giuliani wanted to blow up.

Seems like a few unhappy tenants may want to blow it up, too -- or at least their contracts. A couple who paid almost \$800,000 for a yet-unbuilt apartment, found that the place was 109 square feet smaller than Two Trees had promised -- a 17 percent difference, and one that they call fraud.
